This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey approval of the Board for Approval for Middle Class Syllabus as per details given below :

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The ownership of land is not clear. As per land certificate uploaded by the school, land measuring 6575 Sq. Mtrs. is owned by Karam Chand, by way of lease deed. It means that Karam Chand has sub-leased land to the DAV College Trust and Management Society. However, name of the lessor is not available in the land certificate. School is directed to obtain the land certificate with name of the lessor from the appropriate competent government authority in the format as per Appendix – X and submit compliance.
2	It appears that the school has not constructed a boundary wall in the area adjacent to the ramp, as it has been bounded with the hill (video reference time 26:19), however, school must have a concrete boundary wall upto 6 feet all around the school campus. Further, some part of the boundary wall has not been plastered. Hence, school is directed to construct the wall, get it plastered and submit the compliance.
3	The school has set-up the composite science lab on the wooden tables. The school shall upgraded the same as per Board's SoP with proper stone/metal topped work stations and permanent fixture, bins for biodegradable waste/non-biodegradable waste, adequate seating arrangement (wooden stools instead of plastic stools) and safety features such as fire extinguishers and exhaust fan within 03 months and submit the compliance.
4	The mathematics lab looks like a temporary arrangement with few equipment and more models displayed on tables of different sizes place along the walls. There are no work spaces for students with proper seating and storage. the school shall upgrade the math lab as per SoP issued by the school and submit compliance.
5	Some of the Indian toilets have been seen without flush and water tap. School is required to make provision of water taps and flushes in all the toilets and submit the compliance.

6	The CWSN toilets have not been made as per norms. they are too small with no room to maneuver a wheelchair/walker inside the cubicle. In one CWSN toilet, WC is seen on a raised platform, which defeats the whole purpose of accessible toilets. The school shall construct separate toilets for CWSN, boys and girls on every floor as per norms of RPwD Act and guidelines issued by the Board and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
7	The school is required to apply for upgradation to Secondary or Senior Secondary level within 05 years from the date of grant of Middle Class Syllabus.
8	School is required to upgrade its facilities in the light of SOPs and guidelines issued by the Board, address to the above advisory points, remove the deficiencies mentioned above and submit the proof of compliance through videography within 3 months on the SARAS portal.
9	The school shall ensure the training of its teachers with CoE Panchkula within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
